## Opera Colorado Seeks Individuals to Participate in *Don Giovanni* as Supernumeraries

Supernumeraries serve as characters in non-singing/non-speaking supporting roles, like extras in film and TV

**Denver, CO (September 7, 2023)**—Opera Colorado invites members of the community to apply for six non-singing supernumerary roles in its upcoming production of Mozart's *Don Giovanni*. A supernumerary (usually referred to as a super) contributes to the production by acting in a non-speaking/non-singing role, like being an extra in a movie.

We are seeking to fill the male/male-presenting roles that appear in the following capacity:

- Act one: Male servants of the Commendatore's household who will need to lift and carry off
  his dead body. At the end of the act, the same men will return as Don Giovanni's servants at
  his banquette passing out drinks and desserts on trays. You will be handling trays with
  practical liquids and possibly practical desserts.
- Act two: Don Giovanni's servants return to set up his final dinner with the ghost of the Commendatore.

Supers must be between 5'8" and 6'4" tall with a chest measurement of 40"-46".

All community volunteers who offer their time and talent as supernumeraries will receive:

- Two (2) tickets to the *Don Giovanni* final dress rehearsal on Thursday, November 2.
- Parking/Travel Stipend equal to \$7.50 per day you are called to the opera house.
- Access to up to four (4) discounted tickets to use during the run of *Don Giovanni* performances.

Early staging rehearsals will take place between **October 16 and 24, 2023,** at the Opera Colorado Opera Center in Englewood, Colorado. Technical rehearsals, dress rehearsals, and all performances will take place on varying dates between **Friday, October 27 and November 12, 2023,** at the Ellie Caulkins Opera House at the Denver Performing Arts Complex in downtown Denver. Rehearsals will take place during weekday evenings and weekends, with some daytime availability requested.
